

NATIONAL CAPITALISM: THE ECONOMIC MODEL FOR UKRAINE

In this monograph, the essence and parameters of the economic model, which is appropriate for Ukraine, are specified. The worked out model will ensure Ukraine's way out from the state of ruin, in which it has fallen down in the consequence of wrong governmental macroeconomic policy and monetary policy of The National Bank of Ukraine have been being undertaken during the last 20 years. Such ineffective state approach has led to formation in Ukraine uncompetitive state-monopolistic capitalism economic model of clan-oligarchic nature. The author has substantiated exhaustiveness of this model and the end of its life-cycle.

In the book, the original, solely developed at the conceptual level mechanism is presented which enables to transit from the destructive model of state-monopolistic capitalism to the holistic, creative national capitalism model of European type, focused on formation of export-oriented, innovative-investment economic model with powerful middle class, and comprehensive extension of open, multivarious competitive environment for the benefit of the major part of Ukrainian population.

Inevitability and urgency of such transition has been shown in conditions when the world globalized economy, a part of which is Ukraine, becomes more and more instable and undergoes a phase of downfall in the big Kondratiev's cycle. The role of the state in the old economic model deconstruction has been revealed, and precise mechanism have been worked out and proposed to make an imperative change of the state's regulatory functions in order to form and introduce the new model of national capitalism in Ukraine.
